

## Four considerations when choosing a Covid-19 testing solution

In the unique environment of a superyacht, deploying a Covid testing solution requires a different set of criteria to many other settings. If your yacht is considering testing equipment, our experts recommend taking these factors into account:

1 TEST ACCURACY

- ▶ How accurate do you need the test results to be?
- Within the confines of a yacht, any false positive or false negative test has the potential to be extremely disruptive
- ► Tests need to be specific to SARS-CoV-2 virus, with no cross reactivity in the test with other benign coronaviruses

**2**USABILITY

- How easy is it for non-medically trained crew members to use the solution?
- Does it need test preparation i.e. mixing of reagents or are the cartridges self-contained?
- Can you use the equipment underway? (some equipment can be sensitive to movement)

- Is regular calibration, maintenance and servicing required?
- Do you have ample space on the vessel to store any equipment?

- Does the solution recognise virus variants?
- Do you need the ability to test for other diseases? (not just SARS-CoV-2) specific to yachting environments respiratory, skin infections and mosquito borne diseases.
